Climb Highway 17 along the Los Caminos Antiguos Scenic and Historic Byway through colorful aspen trees and crisp mountain air. Enjoy the views from Conejos Canyon Overlook. You

may even spot the Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad train rumbling by.
