ACTIVITY

Masontown Hike

This trail begins as a gradual climb through a lodgepole pine forest for approximately 0.9 miles to the old mining town ruins of Masontown. If you are feeling adventurous, continue to the summit of Mt. Royal for a spectacular viewpoint of Frisco. After Masontown, the trail becomes very steep, ascending 1,356 ft. in just over a mile.

ACTIVITY

Historic Walking Tour of Frisco

Stop into the Visitor Center at 300 Main Street to grab a town map of Frisco with all the historic stops listed with descriptions. Follow the map to discover historic Frisco, with stops such as Old Town Hall, Frisco Cemetery and Foote's Rest.

LUNCH

ACTIVITY

Walk or Bike Between Copper Mountain and Frisco

This 6-mile rec path between Copper Mountain Resort and Frisco takes you through the Ten Mile mountain range. Enjoy breathtaking views as you make your way between the two areas. For adventurous bikers and hikers, start in Frisco and end in Copper for a strenuous trip! If you're feeling more easy-going, take the free Summit Stage bus from Frisco to Copper, and bike/hike all 6 miles downhill through the mountains. Be sure to look for a variety of mining ruins found along the canyon walls.

Hike Old Dillon Reservoir
