Day 1

### ACTIVITY

## Windy Point Overlook

Heading south on the Silver Thread Scenic and Historic Byway, make a pit stop at Windy Point, east of Lake City. This overlook offers superb views of five fourteeners (mountains that stand more than 14,000 feet in height) and endless views of golden aspens.

### Insider's Tip

#### Pick Up a Guide:

Stop by the Lake City Visitors Center for a Mile Post Guide prior to hitting the road and heading south toward Creede.

## Bachelor Loop Tour

## Pool Table Road Scenic Drive

Views of golden aspens line Pool Table Road, just off the Silver Thread. Scenic views of the Rio Grande River Valley are visible for the first few miles of the trip, which climbs through aspen, spruce and fir to beautiful rolling, grassy, sub-alpine parks. The 9.4-mile scenic drive is accessible by passenger car and leads to Hanson's Sawmill Site.

## **ACTIVITY**

### **Scenic Autumn Drive & Conejos Canyon Overlook**

Take a brisk fall drive starting in Alamosa through the southern end of the San Luis Valley to the beautiful San Juan Mountains along the Conejos River. Climb Highway 17 along the Los Caminos Antiguos Scenic and Historic Byway through colorful aspen trees and crisp mountain air. Enjoy the views from Conejos Canyon Overlook. You may even spot the Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad train rumbling by.

## **Insider's Tip**

### **Make a Pitstop:**

If you have more time, stop at [Elk Creek Bridge](#) before you drive up the switchbacks and take a kayak or tube down the Conejos River (during low water in July and August when it's hot). Stop to see Elk Meadow Ranch on your way back to Mogote on the southeast side of the Conejos River.
