Creede Underground Mining Museum

Educational Activity Background: Creede has had an incredible silver mining history beginning in 1889 continuing until 1985 when the last mine, the Bulldog Mine, closed down. The Creede Underground Mining Museum is a tribute to that history, as it was built totally underground by locals in the early 1990's. Tours are led by retired miners who explain methods of mining and the equipment.
