Headwaters River Journey

Background: One of the world's most precious resources is water. Most of the time we take it for granted as we do dishes, take a shower, run the faucet to brush our teeth and even play in it. The exhibits at the Headwaters River Journey highlight where our water comes from. You are encouraged to think what problems we Coloradans might face if we don't properly take care of water.

Questions to Ask:

1. What are some water problems? *pollution, not enough due to drought, wasting*
2. What can we do to help with water problems? *keeping it clean, turning off water when we aren't using it*
