## Storytelling Bradford Rhea Sculptures

**Background**: Stop by the Logan County Tourist Information Center by the Sterling Rest Area to pick a pamphlet and <u>map</u> of the <u>sculptures created by Bradford Rhea</u>. You can learn more about the sculptures by watching this <u>video</u>, where he talks about his sculptures.
