**Activity:** Explore the path you will take during your road rip. Locate the wall-size illustrated Colorado state map and find the Pioneering Plains region in the upper right-hand side.

**Questions to Ask:**

1. What images located in the Pioneering Plains region do you see on the map?  
*(images include Pony Express, wagons, sunflowers, windmill, pronghorn, carousel, eagle, pheasant, windmill, wind turbine, western painted turtle, Kit Carson County Carousel, grain silos, hunting vests)*
2. Based on the images, what do you think we will see during our trip?
3. Name the top two images you are most interested in learning more about and/or visiting during our trip.
4. During this trip, we will be traveling to the cities of Julesburg, Sterling, Fort Morgan, Limon and Burlington. Find and point to each of the cities on the map.
5. Show which roads you think we should take to visit all the towns?
6. Why did you choose this path? *(Answers will vary; some children might choose the most direct route, others might choose a route that passes the illustrated images they are interested in.)*
