Overland Trail Museum

Background: The Overland Trail Museum tells the story of the heaviest traveled road in America between 1862 and 1868. Explorers, trappers, gold seekers and early pioneers looking to make their fortunes traveled along the route. Behind the main museum building, visitors will find a one-room schoolhouse, blacksmith shop, general store and a church.

Activity: This version of BINGO is a little different than what you're used to. You will be tasked to find objects in the museum that start with each of the letters of OVERLAND. Draw or write what the object is in the following chart next to the corresponding letter. One tricky letter might be V. You may have to add an adjective such as **very, vacant or, valuable**.
